

- 7) To establish and maintain rent-free homes for the poor, sick and needy to give alms to them and also to arrange for their free feeding and clothing.
- 8) To engage in and propagate development of rural areas and help the uplift of rural folk and guide them for establishing village level industries and institutions.
- 9) To propagate, spread and teach the message of self sufficiency at Village, taluk, District, State and National levels and carry on and support all activities towards that end for the good of the country.
- 10) To spread the message of simple living and high thinking and spread the message of the ancient culture of India and the teachings of the sages and seers of India.
- 11) To promote the cause of all types of education by assisting every kind of existing educational institutions, such as schools, colleges and universities by way of cash donations and contributions, to assist in construction of buildings and establishment and maintenance of libraries to provide educational aids, books and to purchase and equip laboratories in educational institutions for promoting and improving the knowledge of students.
- 12) To award scholarships to needy students, to aid poor students and economically backward persons for their studies in educational, occupational and cultural institutions.
- 13) To institute and run free Book Banks and to distribute books journals, Magazines and literature, free of cost or at subsidised rates to poor students.
- 14) To assist in establishing new libraries and provide buildings and books therefor or to maintain existing libraries and to supply books free of cost to such libraries from time to time.
