

- 15) To promote or aid any other general public charitable causes within the meaning of "Charitable Purposes" under the Income Tax Act the time being.
- 16) To promote Social, Economic, Cultural, Spiritual Moral and Educational advancement of all deserving persons, and to hold, organise and conduct seminars, conferences, meetings and to publish, magazines, news letters and other necessary literature.
- 17) To help and encourage the efforts and other activities of like minded institutions for the re-generation of man and society, and to maintain and support social workers in all fields and render help to their families and dependents who may be in need.
- 18) To promote national integration and inculcate and spread the ideas of unity and sovereignty of our motherland, and to propagate promote and spread, moral and ethical values and to aid to propagate, promote character building activities.
- 19) To carry on charitable activities for the benefit of one and all, under the SANATHANA DHARMA principles, and to spread the ancient culture, knowledge and wisdom of the great men of India.
- 20) To collect and maintain a Fund for the objects and purposes of the Trust and in particular to accept donations in cash or kind and gifts of properties (movable or immovable) assignments of Life Insurance Policies etc.
- 21) To accept and make grants in money or otherwise to carryout the objects of the Trust.
- 22) To accept, purchase, construct and maintain or take on lease any buildings or land deemed suitable for the purpose of the Trust.
